

COVID-19 VISITOR GUIDANCE TROY HEALTH AND REHABILITATION CENTER



PROTECT YOURSELF AND YOUR LOVED ONES FROM COVID-19

- If you have had a positive viral test for COVID-19 or have symptoms compatible with COVID-19 we request that you defer all non-urgent in-person visitation until you meet CDC criteria for healthcare settings to end isolation. If you have had close contact with someone with COVID-19 infection, it is safest to defer non-urgent in-person visitation until 10 days after your close contact if you are unable to wear appropriate source control for the duration of your visit.
- Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water for at least 30 seconds or use Alcohol Based Hand Sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.
- Face covering or mask (covering mouth and nose) in accordance with CDC guidance. Avoid close contact with people who are sick and stay home if you are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Remember to maintain social distancing precautions of at least 6 feet.
- Please report directly to your intended visitation location. We ask that you limit your movement throughout the facility and amount of contact with people, other than the resident you are here to visit. If you are visiting in a room where more than one resident is located, you must wear a face covering for the duration of the visit. At the conclusion of your visit please proceed directly to the designated exit.
